## CIVIL COMMITMENT UNDER W&I CODE 6600

- Has been convicted of a sexually violent offense against two or more victims;
- Has a current diagnosed mental disorder which makes him a danger to the health and safety of others; and
- This current mental disorder makes him a danger to the health and safety of others in that it is <u>likely</u> that he will engage in sexually violent <u>predatory</u> behavior without the appropriate treatment and custody.
- \*\* Danger to the health and safety of others: Does not require proof of a recent overt act while the offender is in custody
- \*\* "Likely" to engage in sexually violent criminal behavior:

  because of current mental disorder, respondent

  presents a <u>substantial danger—a serious and well-founded risk</u>, that he will commit such crimes if released.
- \*\* "Predatory" behavior: An act directed toward a stranger, a person of casual acquaintance with whom no substantial relationship exists, or individual with whom relationship established or promoted for primary purpose of victimization.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Need much more than mere possibility

<sup>\*\*</sup> Risk doesn't have to be more than 50%
