

Mr. John Smith

Demographics

- 24 year old
- African American
- Male
- Full-time college student, funded by student loans
- Accommodations for anxiety disorder
- Immature presentation (asked his mother for a pop and when she demurred, he pouted and stomped one foot)

Criminal History

- Convicted of two counts of L&L
- No previous charges/convictions
- Involved an after-school program for which Mr. Smith volunteered
- While walking a child home, he took the child into an isolated area, exposed himself, and masturbated
- Subsequently paid victim small amounts of money to “keep our secret”
- Non-adjudicated allegations of Mr. Smith using Instagram account, claiming to be 16 and requesting videos of young pubescent male children “dancing” in their underwear as part of a “game”
- Mother of 5 year old alleged that she witnessed Mr. Smith and her son taking “selfies” at a trampoline park. She did not know Mr. Smith’s identity but confronted him when she saw him taking photos of her son. Mr. Smith offered his babysitting services “free of charge” which she refused. The mother reported the incident to the park but did not make a police report

Sexual History

- Living Situation
- Lives with mother who is on disability (kidney failure)
- Is mother’s primary support system
- No plans or interest to live independently

Family relationships

- Only child
- Enmeshed with his mother (fusion of emotions, constant use of “we” pronoun)
- Raised by single mother
- Father is a police officer who was uninvolved
- Denied experience of abuse

Education and Employment

- Mr. Smith's academic history has been notably successful in the past.
- Current performance in college is significantly poorer.
- He attributes this decline to anxiety and legal issues rather than his intelligence.
- Mr. Smith experienced mild bullying but asserts social engagement with peers.
- Limited work history but extensive volunteer experience, primarily focused on child-oriented activities.
- Mr. Smith expressed thoughts about finding "loopholes" to regain access to children, which is concerning.
- Recent part-time employment in telemarketing

Leisure and Social Life

- Experienced a reduction in friendships after his index offense became public, feeling lonely and rejected by family and peers.
- Engages in activities such as sports, college events, and movies with friends, with church involvement.
- Shows impulsivity in speeding but claims to be generally cautious.

Substance Abuse

- Drinks occasionally with family but abstains from social drinking due to friends' alcohol abuse.
- Denies drug experimentation.

Sexual and Relationship History

- self-reported heterosexual orientation, later noting that he “wanted” to be attracted to women
- no relationship over lifetime
- no sexual contact with a consenting age-appropriate partner
- acknowledged paedophilic (male-specific) interests
- denies use of “regular” pornography but collects images of male children in underwear for fantasy purposes
- described sexual arousal as “powerful” and resistant to distractions

Medical History

- Reports exaggerated medical history, possibly seeking attention.
- Seven reported head injuries but claimed “refused” medical treatment

Mental Health History

- Contact with mental health services initiated after arrest, diagnosed with adjustment disorder initially.
- Continued therapy for anxiety and depression, with concerns about exaggeration noted in testing.
- Moderate symptoms of depression primarily situational; high post-traumatic stress due to legal process.
- Personality profile suggests chronic maladjustment, immaturity, manipulation tendencies, and dependency.
- One hospitalization for suicidal ideation
- Struggles with anger management, worsened by legal issues.
- Therapy recommended for emotional distress and stress management, with caution regarding dependency issues.
- Mr. Smith expressed interest in treatment but needs to demonstrate willingness to put effort into change.
- Self-described “prolific liar” for both manipulation and just “pleasure”

Risk Assessment

- PCL-R:-- moderate risk for violence
- SORAG—moderate to moderate-high risk
- Statics—moderate-high risk
- STABLE--high
- LS/CMI--low

Diagnosis

- Paedophilic Disorder (exclusive, non-specific but male preference reported)
- (Primary Diagnosis)**
- Query Major Depressive Disorder (mild, possible exaggeration of symptoms) with anxious distress
- Query Fetishistic Disorder (children’s underwear, r/o if children are the primary focus, not the underwear)
- Other Specified Personality Disorder (with mixed features, including dependency, narcissistic, and histrionic traits)
